WHAT IS A G3 GROUP?

"G3" Stands for "Grow Three." A G3 Group is a gender-specific, closed group of 3-5 believers that meet weekly for 12 months for accelerated spiritual transformation.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

The image below shows what G3 Group members commit to weekly in their personal life (weekly disciplines + weekly meeting) and how God will grow them in five different areas over the next 12 months.

WHAT IS THE COMMITMENT?

- Give yourself fully to the Lord during this time as you anticipate a season of accelerated spiritual transformation.
- Meet weekly as a G3 Group (60-90 minutes).
- Commit to the five weekly disciplines (Bible Reading, Journaling, Scripture Memory, Accountability, and Prayer.)
- Contribute to a group atmosphere of confidentiality, honesty, and transparency.
- Pray weekly for fellow G3 Group members and those in your life who don't know Jesus.
- Pray and look for those in your life whom you could invite into your new G3 Group once this current group multiplies.

WHY THREE?

We have found that a group consisting of **one leader** and **three others** offers the necessary interaction and support to sustain these groups and promote **accountability**. Biblically, Jesus had twelve disciples but really **poured into three** (Peter, James, & John). **Bottom Line.** Does it have to be three? No. You could start a group with two or four. However, three is IDEAL.

WHAT IS THE GOAL OF G3 GROUPS?

The goal of G3 Groups is to **develop disciples of Jesus who make disciples**. We call this **reproducing**. At the end of the year, our heart's desire is for each of the individuals in the group **start their own G3 Group** and help disciple others to do likewise. (2 Tim. 2:2)

DO G3 GROUPS FOLLOW A PLAN?

Yes, over the course of a year, your G3 Group will progress through four parts centered around discipleship: Gaining Perspective, The Daily Disciplines, Walking in Freedom, and Leading in Faith. There are study guides for each of these parts that will direct your study and aid your discussion. Scripture memory verses are also indicated for each week.
